



## **Internal rules and regulations**

### **regarding the currently required hygiene measures in the Werkbundarchiv – Museum of Things**

Dear visitors,

We are pleased to welcome you to the Werkbundarchiv - Museum der Dinge. In accordance with the regulation on necessary measurements to contain the spread of the coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 in Berlin, we would like to draw your attention to the following rules and hygiene measures.

1. Tickets for the museum visit can be purchased both online and on site.
2. Visitors who have had contact with a person infected with COVID-19 in the last 14 days or who are suffering from a respiratory infection themselves are not allowed to enter the museum.
3. The 3 G rule no longer applies. Wearing an FFP2 or medical mask is mandatory. We recommend maintaining a minimum distance of 1.5 meters.
4. The following rules apply to events (e.g. lectures, openings with speeches or workshops):  
The 3G rule does not apply to events either. There is also an obligation to wear an FFP2 mask here. We also recommend maintaining a minimum distance of 1.5 meters here.
5. Do not cough or sneeze in your hands, but in the crook of your arm.
6. Admissions or purchases in the museum shop are to be made without using cash if possible.

These internal regulations have been updated to take into account the Hygiene framework concept for cultural institutions in the State of Berlin dated 01.03.2022 and will come into force on 01.03.2022.

By entering the museum rooms you acknowledge the house rules. The regulations in force are constantly evaluated and updated to make your visit to the museum as safe and enjoyable as possible.
